## Old Business:

2. **100 Thousand Poets for Change** – The recorded Protest workshop by Howard Moon and Open mic have both been edited and uploaded to the NFPH YouTube channel and posted on the 100K Poets for Change 2023 website page on our chapter website.
3. **West Coast Student Poetry Contest April 2024** – The planning committee for this project will meet again later in the year as Suzanne progresses with conversations with the school in Brandon.

## New Business:

1. NFPH Holiday party – Those in attendance agreed we would once again use the December Poetry Hub as our designated on-line Holiday party, which would be 12/19/23.
2. We also agreed to hold the November and December Chapter meetings on a weekday evening from 7-8 instead of the last Saturday afternoons as these both fall on holiday weekends in November and December so that plans for the Poetry Showcase can continue to be put together. Dates to be announced. Ruth will send out materials to give members enough information to provide feedback.
3. A Gathering of Poets wants to run their Young Voices Poetry Contest again and will take care of the program themselves without involving any other parties.
4. We discussed the date of March 30<sup>th</sup> for the First Coast Poetry Showcase and I asked Sharon to request Hope of The Gathering of Poets to go about securing the SE Regional Library location for us again on that date (or the weekend preceding that if necessary, the 30<sup>th</sup> being the preferred date.)

5. We brought up the topic of considering the “theme” for NFPH’s readers and what they might use for their readings. The first year was the Poets Pen, second year the Goals anthology. This year could be.... ?
6. I proposed suggesting to Hope At Hand that NFPH run a separate poetry contest for their JAX Poetry Fest in April that is independent of our First Coast Poetry Showcase.
