TALLY COLUMNS:

* Monthly goal set by the individual participant at their discretion

- "PERSONAL GOAL" is the personal goal you set at the beginning of the year (24).
- "ACHIEVED GOAL" is a running tally of actual submissions turned in (26).

Project Guidelines....

Who Can Participate.....

- Existing members of NFPH and regular attendees must enroll in January of 2024.
- Attendees who come into the group up until June 30th may join the C-S-C program up until June 30th.
- New members of NFPH may join at any time during 2024.
- Members of NFPH can participate without attendance obligation to qualify for inclusion in the Anthology.
- Non-members must attend a minimum of one workshop or meeting each month while in the program to qualify for inclusion in Anthology.

Setting Personal Goals

- Carefully consider the Personal Goal number you set for yourself at enrollment.
- Make your Personal Goal a number you can reasonably achieve and yet is a challenge.
- Once your Personal Goal is set that number can not be changed.

Reporting Submissions...

- Participants are required to submit a report to the record-keeper monthly the title(s) submitted and publication name(s) no later than the 5th.
- ** Participants are <u>required to report, even with zero submissions</u>.
- One late or missed report per year allowed.
- Any participant found falsifying submission numbers will be dropped from the program immediately.

How to Count Submissions...

How To Count Your Submissions:

- A publication is calling for <u>one type of work</u> (example poem or short story) and you submit one piece. This is counted as <u>one submission</u>.
- A publication is calling for <u>one type of work, but you are allowed to submit two or more pieces</u>. Only one will be selected. <u>This is counted</u> as one submission.

How To Count Your Submissions cont:

• A publisher is calling for <u>multiple categories</u>. Example: Poems and Short stories. You submit one piece of work to each category (1 poem and 1 short story).

This is counted as two submissions.

• Open Mic's, Reading engagements, appearances, poems that are requested to be written (not being submitted for consideration), blogs, ect. are not submissions and can not be used for points in the goals program.

Counting Contest Submissions:

• For instance FSPA contests. There are multiple individual categories, each separate category counts as 1 submission. You submit poetry entries to 5 different categories. This counts as 5 separate submissions.

• If you enter a contest category that allows more than one poem entry <u>per</u> <u>that category</u>, that still counts as <u>one submission</u>.

The Anthology: Disqualification for inclusion...

- Monthly goal reports aren't turned in by the 5th of each month (with exception of one "grace" month per year .. You must submit a goals report, **even if you had no submissions**.
- Annual accumulated goals are not achieved.
- You have zero submissions more than two months a year without extenuating circumstances that are discussed with the goals keeper at that time.
- Non-members don't meet attendance requirements of at least one workshop or meeting per month.

Comment:


• No one will be dropped from the Program for failure to report monthly submissions on time, attendance requirements or meeting goals. The only consequence is that you won't be included in the Anthology.


