Old Business:

- 2. **March 25**th "First Coast Poetry Showcase". We have a confirmed reservation at the Southeast Regional Library in Jacksonville near Town Center. We will be allowed to sell books with the caveat we do not advertise book sales.
- NFPH will be responsible for the cost of refreshments at the Showcase and any other miscellaneous costs and production such as programs and fliers.
- Pat and Ruth will coordinate the **purchase of refreshments**. Monetary donations would be most helpful or check with Pat and Ruth about what you could bring to the event. Checks could be mailed to Pat or Shutta. Again, contact Ruth or Pat for this.
- Press releases have begun. Ruth is doing this. Members are encouraged assist in promotions by distributing fliers, share the FB event on their pages, and spread the word, invite friends. If you know of an outlet for a press release, please contact Ruth so she can be sure and include this in with the rest. Thank you
- **Book Sales** will be coordinated by Chris Kastle. Shutta Crum is also working with her to arrange for credit card sales to increase sales. Details forthcoming.
- First Coast Young Voices High School Poetry Contest status (Shutta / Sharon). A Gathering of Poets is sponsoring the Contest with Prizes set at 1st \$200 2nd \$100 and 3rd \$75 with honorable mentions \$50. Entries are beginning to come in from the schools to Sharon Scholl.
- Readers ~ First Coast Poetry Showcase: There was only one idea submitted from the members of how to choose readers at the showcase. This was a great idea and very fair – to assign points to each member based on activities participated in, i.e. a point for

submitting a poem to the poetry scroll project, poem to the nursing home cards, attending meetings, workshops, being on a committee, leading a workshop/facilitator, submitting to a FSPA contest, poem in Cadence, etc. Then the members were ranked by total numbers. The ones with the highest numbers were chosen to read. It was agreed unanimously at the meeting that this was a fair system to use. It was also the only idea that was submitted for choosing who would be chosen to read at the showcase.

- Theme of readings at showcase: The theme was discussed. When looking at those people who had the highest activity levels in general, they all had one thing in common they were included in the upcoming Goals Anthology. It was agreed that this would be a great opportunity to talk about the Create-Submit-Celebrate Goals Project within the NFPH Chapter and so decided that the readers include one of their poems they had in the Goals Anthology and one poem at their discretion.
